**:-O R D E R:-**

The present petition is filed U/Sec.13(3) of The Registration of Births and Death Act seeking an order directing the respondent to enter the event of death of **grant father of petitioners, Late Singaiah S/o Late Bettaiah** (hereinafter referred to as deceased) in the register of births and death, who allegedly died on **12-04-1982** at Alambadikavalu village, Akkihebbalu Hobli, Krishnarajpet Taluk, Mandya District in the concerned register.

2. The case of the petitioners are that, deceased was the resident of Alambadikavalu village, Akkihebbalu Hobli, Krishnarajpet Taluk, Mandya District and died on **12-04-982**. The said event of death of the deceased is not entered in the concerned register of births and deaths maintained by the respondent. A necessary application was filed before the respondent with necessary particulars to enter the event of death of the deceased. As the application was barred by time, the respondent rejected the application on that sole ground, but however, the respondent issued a non-availability certificate dated : 12-01-2026. The petitioners seeking death certificate of the deceased for their bonafide use/change of Revenue records and they prayed to issue necessary directions to respondent to enter the event of death of deceased in the concerned of Birth and Deaths and to issue necessary certificate in that effect.
3. Despite due service of notice, the respondent absent and accordingly placed ex-parte.
4. In order to prove their case, petitioner No.1 got examined himself as PW.1 and marked 5 documents at Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.5 and closed their side evidence.

5. Heard the arguments. The point that arises for my consideration is:

**1) Whether the petitioner proves that, the event of death of the deceased Late Singaiah S/o Late Bettaiah was not entered in the register maintained by the respondent?**

6. My answer to the above point is in the **affirmative**, for the following.

### **REASONS**

7. **Point No.1:-** The petitioner No.1 in his evidence affidavit reiterated the petition averments and he has deposed that, the deceased was died on **12-04-1980**. He is seeking death certificate for the purpose of getting transfer revenue entries of the deceased in their name. The testimony of petitioners remained unchallenged. There is no oath against the oath. Usually courts believe the statement made on oath. It appears the respondent after thorough verification in the village of the petitioners have issued non-availability certificate marked as Ex.P.1. The respondent has not denied the event of death of the deceased. In spite of publication of notice in two daily newspapers calling upon the objectors to file objections if

any none of the objectors appeared before the court and filed any objections. The respondents though served with the notice not appeared before the court and resisting the petition. Such being the case there is no reason to deny the version of the petitioners. Thus, the petitioners have proved their case that the deceased was died on **12-04-1982** at Alambadikavalu village, Akkihebbalu Hobli, Krishnarajpet Taluk, Mandya District in the concerned register.

8. In view of the above, I answer point no.1 in the **Affirmative** and pass the following.

**:-O R D E R:-**

**The petition filed by the petitioner U/Sec.13(3) of The Registration of Birth and Deaths Act 1969 is hereby allowed.**

**It is hereby directed the respondent to enter the event of death of the deceased by name Late Singaiah S/o Late Bettaiah who died on 12-04-1982 at Alambadikavalu village, Akkihebbalu Hobli, Krishnarajpet Taluk, Mandya**

**District in the concerned register  
subject to payment of late fee etc.**

**No order as to cost.**
