I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that he himself and defendant No. 1 to 9 are the members of Hindu undivided joint family and suit schedule properties are their joint family properties?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 06.09.1999 executed by the 1st defendant in favour of 7th defendant with respect to suit schedule item No.11 of the property is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
3. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 08.02.2002 executed by the 1st defendant in favour of late M. Shankaregowda with respect to suit schedule item No.14 and 15 of the properties is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 30.06.2006 executed by the 1st defendant in favour of 6th defendant with respect to suit schedule item No.4 and 9 of the properties is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
5. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 17.08.2011 executed by the defendant No.1 and 2 in favour of late Shankaregowda and 8th defendant with respect to suit schedule item No.1 of the property is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
6. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 17.08.2011 executed by the 1st defendant in favour of 9th

- defendant with respect to suit schedule item No.3 of the property is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
7. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered gift deed dated 20.08.2011 executed by the 1st defendant in favour of 8th defendant with respect to suit schedule item No.3 of the property is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
 8. Whether the plaintiff proves that registered sale deed dated 07.07.2014 executed by the defendant No.1, 2 and 8 in favour of defendant No.11 and 12 with respect to suit schedule item No.12 of the property is null and void and not binding on his legitimate share?
 9. Whether the defendant No.8 proves that suit schedule item No. 3 and 24 are the self acquired properties of 1st defendant?
 10. Whether the defendant No.3 and 4 prove that already partition effected between the members of joint family as alleged in para No.10 of their written statement?
 11. Whether the defendant No.3 and 4 prove that suit filed by the plaintiff is barred by non inclusion of all the joint family properties?
 12. Whether the defendant No.3 and 4 prove that suit schedule item No. 20 and 21 are the self acquired properties of deceased Shankaregowda?
 13. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for mesne profit as sought for?
 14. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief as sought for?
 15. What Order or Decree?
