

Before Lok-adalath

Matter taken up before Lok-adalath. Petitioner present. Both counsel present. Both counsel have presented the joint memo stating that the matter is settled between the parties for Rs. 4,63,000/-. Respondent No. 2 company has admitted to pay the same to the petitioner. Petitioner admits the terms of the joint memo. Memo is duly signed by both the parties and their counsel. As the respondent No.2 is company memo filed on its behalf by its counsel is accepted. The matter stands disposed of as settled before Lok-adalath in terms of the joint memo.

Office to draw award accordingly. Joint memo shall form part and parcel of the award.

Further, as the matter is settled before the Lok-adalath and as it is submitted by the petitioner that he had incurred loan to bear the huge hospital expenses, on deposit of the

settlement amount the entire settlement is ordered to be paid to the petitioner on proper identification and verification.
