The petitioner and the Respondent No.2 have filed joint memo by stating that the claim petition filed by the petitioner has been settled between them amicably for a sum of Rs.6,88,189/- (Rupees Six lakh eighty eight thousand one hundred eighty nine only).

Contents of the Joint memo read over to the Petitioner in Kannada language known to him. The Petitioner admit the contents of joint memo.

Perused the terms of the settlement. The settlement between the parties to the proceeding is just and reasonable. The same appears to be lawful.

Hence, it is proper to accept the same. Hence, in view of settlement reported by the petitioner and the respondent No.2, we proceed to pass the following:

Consequently, the petition filed by the petitioner U/s 166 of Motor Vehicle Act is allowed in terms of Joint memo.

Respondent No. 2 is hereby directed to shall transfer compensation amount of Rs.6,88,189/- (Rupees Six lakh eighty eight thousand one hundred eighty nine only) directly to the bank account of the petitioner.

Draw Award accordingly after furnishing the bank details by the petitioner.
