**COMMON ORDERS ON I.A.**

**No.13 to 15**

1. The Plaintiff filed I.A.No.13 under section 151 of CPC with a prayer to reopen the case from the stage of further defendant evidence to the stage of further chief of PW-1.

2. The plaintiff filed IA No.14 under order 18 Rule 17 read with Section 151 of CPC with a prayer to recall P.W.1 for further chief examination.

3. The plaintiff filed IA No. 15 under order 7 rule 14(a) of CPC with a prayer to permit the file of documents by condoning the delay.

4. In the duly sworn affidavits annexed to the said applications, plaintiff has stated that, he intending to file the relevant documents in support of his case and he collected the same very recently. And the same documents are very much required to prove his case. Hence the applications.

5. The said applications are resisted by the defendant No.1 by filing the objections. In the objections it is stated that, plaintiff filed the present application at the belated stage, only with an intention to drag the

proceedings. It is also contended that there is no merit in the applications filed by the plaintiff. With all these, contentions defendant No.1 prays to dismiss the applications.

6. Here it is pertinent to note that, it is a definite contention of the plaintiff that, documents which he intends to file are required to prove his case. If an opportunity is not given to the parties to prove their case by adducing documentary evidence then it leads to multiplicity of the proceedings and miscarriage of justice. Anyhow, the inconvenience caused to the defendants can be compensated by imposing cost on the plaintiffs.

7. Hence by considering the facts and circumstances IA No.13 to 15 filed by the plaintiff are hereby allowed at the cost of Rs.500/.

8. Consequently documents filed Under IA No. 15 are taken on record.
