

### **ORDERS ON I.A.NO.1**

This is an application filed by the plaintiffs seeking an ad-interim order of injunction against the defendant No.17 restraining him and his men from alienating or changing the nature of the suit schedule properties till the disposal of the present suit.

The application is supported with the affidavit of the plaintiff. In his affidavit, he has stated that he has filed the present suit for partition and separate possession of the suit schedule properties. He has also produced the necessary documents in support of his contention. I have gone through the entire contents of the affidavit and that of the documents placed on record. It is clearly revealed at this stage that the plaintiff has made out some prima facie materials to consider his request made in I.A.No.1. If no such exparte temporary injunction is granted, definitely the rights of the plaintiff will be deprived and the plaintiff will be put to irreparable loss and hardship. Further, the purpose of filing this suit will be defeated if such an exparte temporary injunction is not granted in favour of the plaintiff. Hence, I proceed to pass the following :-

#### **order**

The defendant No.17, his agents or anybody acting on his behalf are hereby restrained from alienating or changing the nature of the suit schedule properties till the next date of hearing by way of ad-interim exparte temporary injunction.

The plaintiff is hereby directed to comply the said order as per the provisions U/o.39 Rule 3 of CPC without fail.

Office is hereby directed to issue exparte temporary injunction, if the same is duly complied by the plaintiff.

Issue emergent notice on I.A. No.1 and S.S. to defendants, if steps taken.
