

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are the joint family properties of plaintiffs and defendants?
2. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that the plaintiffs and defendants are in joint possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule properties?
3. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that there was a partition in the joint family properties in the year 1992 as contended at para No.12 of his written statement?
4. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession of their 72 ½ /100 share in all the suit schedule properties by metes and bounds?
5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for mesne profit u/o 20 Rule 12 of CPC?
