4. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that sale deed dated 04.02.2016 with reference to item No.32 in favour of defendant No.8 is not binding on their shares ?
5. Whether the defendant 3 to 6 proves that there was previous partition and legally and in sound state of mind a Will was executed by C.Siddegowda as contended in para 4 of the written statement ?
6. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for share in suit schedule properties as sought for ?
7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the declaratory reliefs as sought for ?
8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs as sought for?
9. What order or decree?
