

ORDERS ON IA DATED 16.03.2021

IA dated 16.03.2021 is filed by the plaintiff U/o 32 Rule 14-A r/w/sec.151 of CPC to discharge the guardian of defendant. It is accompanied by affidavit. Objection is not filed to the said application.

Heard the plaintiff counsel and perused the records. The suit is filed for specific performance relief. During the pendency of the suit, the defendant was reported dead and her LR who is the minor son of the defendant was brought on record. Subsequently, the guardian of minor LR of defendant appeared through the counsel before this Court. Subsequently, present application was filed to discharge the guardian on the ground that LR of defendant has attained age of majority. In spite of due service of said application to the other side, no objection was filed. Hence, in the absence of objection to said application, this Court is convinced that the minor LR of defendant has attained the age of majority and the guardian should be discharged from guardianship. Based on above observation, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

IA dated 16.03.2021 filed U/o 32 Rule 14-A r/w/sec.151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Guardian of LR of defendant is
discharged from guardianship.
