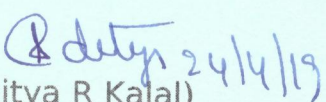

2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the sale deeds dated 10.09.2002, 26.10.2002, 6.07.2004, 10.06.2004, 13.08.2006 and 20.10.2000 in respect of suit schedule properties are not binding on them?
3. Whether the defendant No.11 proves that Chikkaboomaiah S/o Bomma @ Kariyaiah is the absolute owner of the suit schedule property?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that they are entitled for 1/3rd share in the share of Late Ningaiah?
5. Whether the plaintiffs prove that they are entitled for the relief as sought for?
6. What order or decree?
