ORDER BELOW (EXH.1) IN LOKADALAT

The offence is charge against accused is under section 303 (2) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, which is compoundable. Therefore, in view of (Exh.2) to (Exh.4) the case is withdrawn, as compounded. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. In view of order passed below (Exh.-2) to (Exh.-4) permission granted to withdraw the complaint.
2. The accused is acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 303 (2) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 vide Section 359 (8) of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023
3. Bail bonds of the accused stands cancelled.
4. Seized property if any not returned it be returned to it's lawful owner, as per law or if it already returned to it's lawful owner, the indemnity bond, executed by lawful owner of seized property stands cancelled.
