The petitioner is appeared through V.C. The petitioner is agreed to settled the dispute.

The Petitioner and his advocate and the advocate for respondent No. 2 are filed Joint Memo.

The respondent No. 2 is absent. For which the counsel on record submits that, the respondent No. 2 has agreed to settle the dispute for Rs.3,30,000/- payable to the petitioner. Accordingly, they have filed a Joint compromise memo requesting to dispose off the case in terms of compromise.

I have gone through the contents of the joint memo. Read-over and explained the same to the petitioner. He has accepted the contents and terms of the compromise as correct. Hence the joint memo is accepted and the case is disposed off accordingly.

The respondent No.2 is hereby directed to transfer entire amount of settlement to the petitioner bank account within 60 days from the date of settlement.

Draw the award accordingly.

Petitioner shall submit affidavit furnishing petitioner's nationalized bank account details with IFSC along with canceled cheque having petitioner's name within 30 days from today. Petitioner shall also submit copy of bank account passbook, Aadhar card and Pan card. The counsel for the petitioner shall verify the authenticity of the details and submit the same to the office along with memo.

Pending clerk and CMO shall verify and endorse the correctness of the bank details in the order sheet to enable drawing of the award.

Office to include all above details of petitioner and draw award after receipt of memo from the counsel for the petitioner.

The respondent No.2 shall transfer the award amount to the bank account specified in the award and intimate to this tribunal.

Failure to furnish aforesaid details within 30 days shall dis-entitle the petitioner to interest until such compliance.
