

### **ORDERS ON I.A.NO.I**

This is a suit filed by the plaintiff against the defendant for the relief of declaration. The IA No.1 is filed by the plaintiff under **Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 r/w Sec.151 of CPC** seeking an ad-interim order of temporary injunction restraining the defendant, her agents, servants or anybody acting on her behalf from alienating the suit schedule property to anybody, in any manner, till pending disposal of the suit.

2. The application is supported with the affidavit of the plaintiff. I have gone through the affidavit and the documents produced by the plaintiff. At this stage, I am of the view that the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case and urgency in this matter. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

### **ORDER**

**The I.A.No.I filed by the plaintiff is hereby allowed.**

**The defendant, her agents, servants, or anybody on her behalf are restrained from alienating the suit schedule property**

in favour of anybody, in any manner, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is hereby directed to comply the exparte temporary injunction under the provision of Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC without fail.

Issue suit summons, notice on I.A.No.1 and temporary injunction order to the defendant after compliance.
