

ORDERS

The Decree Holder has filed the present application under Section 151 of CPC, 1908, seeking police protection and necessary directions for effective execution of the Judgment and Decree dated 05/04/2023 passed in O.S. No. 282/2018, whereby the Judgment Debtor and her relatives were permanently restrained from interfering with or entering into the matrimonial life and residence of the Decree Holder.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the Decree Holder and perusing the material on record, it is evident that despite the permanent injunction granted by this Court, the Judgment Debtor and her relatives continue to indulge in trespass, interference, and harassment of the Decree Holder, thereby necessitating police protection for enforcement of the decree.

Accordingly, the application is allowed. It is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Jurisdictional Police (Belakavadi Police Station or any other competent police station) shall provide protection to the

Decree Holder and ensure effective enforcement of the Judgment and Decree dated 05/04/2023 passed in O.S. No. 282/2018.

2. The Police shall remove and restrain the Judgment Debtor Smt. R. Sowmya and her relatives from entering, interfering, or trespassing into the matrimonial home and life of the Decree Holder in any manner whatsoever.

3. The Police shall take appropriate legal action, including arrest and detention, against the Judgment Debtor and her relatives if they violate the decree or indulge in any harassment or illegal activity as alleged.

4. The Judgment Debtor and her relatives shall strictly comply with the permanent injunction decree passed by this Court, failing which coercive action shall be initiated as per law.
