1. Whether the plaintiff proves that he and defendant are the joint family members and suit schedule properties are their ancestral and joint family properties and available for partition ?
2. Whether the defendant proves that the item No.7 of the suit property was purchased by her father by name Srinivasaiah through registered sale deed dated:11.02.1991 and item No.7 of the suit property is the self acquired property of her father and he has executed gift deed in her favour on 10.08.2011 in respect of item No.7 of the suit property ?
3. Whether the defendant proves that item No.2, 5 and 6 are the self acquired properties of her mother by name Mayamma and the said properties are maternal properties of Mayamma and plaintiff has no right over the item No.2, 5 and 6 of the suit properties ?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that he is entitled for 1/2 share in the suit schedule properties ?
5. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for mesne profits ?
6. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs as sought in the plaint ?
7. What Order or Decree?
