SUBSTANCE OF ACCUSATION

It is alleged that you have issued a cheque bearing No.592412 dated: 20.04.2022 drawn on Canara Bank, Nagamangala branch, for Rs.3,80,000/- in favour of complainant for discharge of legally recoverable debt or liability. When the said cheque was presented to the banker for collection, it returned dishonoured on 27.04.2022 with bank endorsement “**Funds Insufficient**”. When the complainant issued a notice on 04.05.2022 calling upon you to pay the cheque amount, you failed to repay the same within 15 days from the date of service of notice and thereby committed an offence punishable U/Sec.138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and within my cognizance.
