PROCEEDING BEFORE LOK-ADALATH

Case called out before Lok Adalath on 11.07.2026.

Petitioner present. Both counsel present and filed joint compromise memo.

Perused the joint memo filed by them. They have voluntarily got settled their claim as full and final settlement for Rs.27,00,000/-. (Twenty Seven Lakhs.)

Further, they have submitted that the respondent No.2 agreed to deposit the said amount within two months, in default of it respondent No.2, shall pay award amount with an interest at the rate of 6% per annum. Advocate for petitioner filed application U/O 32 Rule 7 of CPC along with certificate. Perused the records, compromise joint memo, wherein, parties entered the compromise for the benefit and welfare of the minor petitioner No.2 and 3. As such, application is allowed. Hence, joint memo filed by them is voluntary one.

Further, Office is hereby directed that 15% each of the amount of the compensation order to be deposited National Bank in the name of the petitioner No.2 and 3 till attaining majority.

Remaining 15% each of the amount is

order to be released in favour of the petitioner No.4 and 5 and remaining 40% to be released in favour of the petitioner No.1 in accordance with law.

As per memo matter is settled.

Office is hereby directed draw award accordingly.
