



ORDERS ON IA No-I

The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of Partition and Separate Possession and such other reliefs in respect of suit schedule properties.

2. The plaintiff has also maintained an application U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w Sec.151 of CPC by seeking for grant of an order of exparte ad-interim temporary injunction restrain the defendant no.1, 2 and 6 from alienating the suit 'A' and 'B' schedule properties by way of sale, mortgage, transfer etc., until pending disposal of the suit.

3. In support of his case, the plaintiff has produced RTC extracts, Demand register extract, Mutation extract, Maintenance Petition and Compromise petition filed in the Crl.Misc.No.104/2005 to prove his prima-facie case.

4. On perusal of the documents and pleadings, at this stage the plaintiff has not made out prima-facie grounds to issue an order of exparte temporary injunction. Hence, it is just and necessary to pass an order on IA No.I after service of notice to the defendants. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

Issue suit summons to the defendants no.1 to 7 and emergent notice on IA No-I to the defendant no.1, 2 and 6. Returnable by 04.02.2022.
