

The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendant for the relief of permanent injunction with regard to suit schedule property.

2. The plaintiff has also maintained an application u/o 39 rule 1 and 2 of CPC by seeking for grant exparte temporary injunction against the defendants and his agents, servants not to interfering the suit schedule property until disposal of the above suit.

3. In support of his case, the plaintiff has furnished copies of resolution copy, M.R. Extract, legal notice, Mandya Zilla Panchayath petition copy and two photos and one C.D. to prove his prima facie case.

4. On Perusal of the case papers and documents, it is come to know that, the schedule mentioned in the documents and in the plaint is one and the same. Hence, avoid the multiplicity of the proceedings and also interest of the safeguard of the suit schedule property this court considered the applications reason's. This opinion is only with regard to issuance of status quo order. When the defendant will appear before the Court, the true picture with regard to possessor of the suit schedule property would appear. Hence, in this case, till appearance of defendant, an order or exparte status quo order is deserves. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue exparte status quo order over the suit schedule property to both parties to maintain status quo till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is directed to comply the order under order 39 rule 3 (a) & (b) of C.P.C.

Issue emergent notice on I.A. No.I, and suit summons to defendant, if steps taken. R/by 05.04.2019.
