

### **ORDER ON I.A. NO.I**

Plaintiffs have filed I.A. No.I Under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 r/w/s 151 of CPC for grant of ex-parte temporary injunction restraining the defendant no.1 and 2 from alienating the suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

2. Heard. Perused the I.A, plaint and the accompanying documents. On perusal of the available materials, it reveals that the plaintiffs have filed a suit for Partition and Separate Possession against the defendants.

3. At this stage, this court noticed that the plaintiffs have made out a prima facie case to grant an ad-interim ex-parte order of temporary injunction against the defendant no.1 and 2 by dispensing with the notice on I.A. No.1. If ex-parte order of Temporary injunction is not granted, the very purpose of filing the I.A. would be defeated. Accordingly, proceed to pass the following;

**ORDER**

Issue Ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction against the defendant no.1 and 2 restraining them from alienating the suit schedule property till the next date of hearing.

Plaintiffs have to comply with the provisions of Order XXXIX Rule 3(a) of CPC. And no certified copy of this order shall be granted to the plaintiffs unless they comply with Order XXXIX Rule 3(a) of CPC.

*This order will be in force till the next of hearing.*

*to defendants.*
