Again case called at about 3.35 pm. No representation from petitioner and her advocate. On perusal of order sheet, it indicates that on 20.01.2024 the petitioner has filed claim petitioner before the court of Prl. District and Sessions Judge, Mandya. The said case made over before this court as per order dated 22.01.2024. This tribunal ordered for issue process against respondent. The process issued against respondent returned as duly served. Respondent absent. Therefore, he placed exparte on 19.03.2024.

After that, this court adjourned the matter for a purpose petitioner evidence from 07.05.2024, 25.06.2024, 13.08.2024, 01.10.2024, 19.11.2024, 07.01.2025 and 17.02.2025. Despite provided sufficient number of adjournments. Petitioner and her counsel regularly absent before court and petitioner has
