

Sri. LKS., advocate filed vakalath for accused No.1.

Accused No.1 present and submits that he is ready to admits the guilt.

Prosecution papers furnished to the accused No.1 as required under Sec 230 of BNSS.

Substance of accusation read over to the accused No.1 in Kannada Language known to him for the offences punishable U/sec. 281, of BNSS – 2023 and Sec. 196 of IMV Act. The accused No.1 voluntarily admits the guilt of the above said offences. Hence, the accused No.1 is convicted for the offences punishable U/sec. 281, of BNSS – 2023 and Sec. 196 of IMV Act. and sentenced him to pay fine as follows;

For Sec. 281 of BNSS to pay a fine of **Rs. 1,000/-** and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo S.I for 1 month.

For Sec. 196 of IMV Act to pay a fine of **Rs. 2,000/-** and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo S.I for 1 month.

The total fine amount is **Rs 3,000/-** and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo total S.I for two months.

Accused is present. The counsel for accused has filed IA. U/s 72(2) of BNSS. Heard, perused, and warned to be regular. Hence, IA. allowed on cost of **Rs. 500/-**. Cost shall payable to state forthwith.

Subject to payment of cost NBW issued against accused is here by cancelled. Issue intimation jurisdictional SHO and IO.

Accordingly, this case disposed off.
