

Case advanced. Learned MTS., advocate has filed vakalath for accused No.1.

Accused No.1 is present and submits that he is ready to admits the guilt.

Prosecution papers furnished to the accused No.1 has required under Sec 207 of Cr.P.C.

Substance of accusation read over to the accused No.1 in Kannada Language known to him for the offences punishable U/sec. 281 of BNS and Sec. 181(3) and 187 of IMV Act. The accused No.1 voluntarily admits his guilt of the above said offences. Hence, the accused No. 1 is convicted for the offences punishable U/sec. 281 of BNS and Sec. 181(3) and 187 of IMV Act and sentenced him to pay fine as follows;

For Sec. 281 of BNS to pay a fine of Rs. 1,000/- and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo S.I for 1 month.

For Sec. 187 of IMV Act to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo S.I for 15 days month.

For Sec. 181(1) of IMV Act to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default fine amount the accused No.1 shall undergo S.I for 15 days month.

The total fine amount is Rs 11,000/- and in default fine amount the accused shall undergo total S.I for two months.

The counsel for accused no.1 has filed IA. U/s 72(2) of BNSS. Heard, perused, and warned to be regular. Hence, IA. allowed on cost of Rs. 200/-. Cost shall payable to state forthwith.

Subject to payment of cost NBW issued against accused no.1 is here by cancelled. Issue intimation jurisdictional SHO.
