ISSUES

1. Whether the petitioner proves that on 22.10.2022 at about 7.00 p.m. on Pandavapura – Nagamangala main road near Banagatta Plegamma temple, while the petitioner in order to go to work at Mysore was riding the two wheeler motor cycle bearing Reg.No.KA-11-S-3455, at that time, the driver of the Swift car bearing Reg.No.KA-22-Z-0251 came in a rash and negligent manner and dashed against his motor cycle, as a result, he sustained injuries?
2. Whether the petitioner proves that, the Maruthi car 800 bearing Reg.No.KA-02-N-0092 which was coming back of his vehicle also dashed to his two wheeler?
3. Whether the respondent No.1 proves that, the accident was occurred due to negligence act on the part of petitioner himself?
4. Whether the respondent No.1 proves that, the Maruthi Swift car bearing Reg.No.KA-22-Z-0251 was insured with 3rd respondent at the time of accident?
5. Whether the respondent No.3 proves that the Maruthi Swift car bearing Reg.No.KA-22-Z-0251 was not insured with this respondent as on the date of accident?
6. Whether the respondent No.3 proves that the petition is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties since the owner and insurer of the Maruthi car bearing Reg.No.KA-01-N-0092 are not made as parties in this petition?

7. Whether the respondent No.3 proves that driver of the Maruthi Swift car bearing Reg.No.KA-22-Z-0251 was not holding valid and effective driving license as on the date of
8. Whether the petitioner is entitled for compensation? If so, what is the compensation and from whom?
9. What order or award?
