Learned counsel for Dhr present. Process of attachment of movable properties issued with Jdr no1 and 2 returned with shara un executed since want of Dhr help. The present execution petition filed on 25.09.2025. Despite provided sufficient time. Process of this court not yet executed on Jdrs. Despite directed to assist court officers for effective execution of process issued by this court. The Dhr not yet assist his co operation for execution of process of attachment of movables. This case already took more than 6 months. Despite that, it could not possible to decide. **In view of the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in RSB.No.163/2025 dated 01.04.2025 and in view of the directions passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.3640-3642/2025(arising out of Slp (c)8490/8492/2020 (Periyammal (Dead) through Lrs and ORS V/s V. Rajamani and Anr etc.,).**

This court has been directed by the Hon'ble Apex court and Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka to decide or dispose execution cases within 6 months.

So in view of directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble High court of Karnataka. The above matter pending since 27.09.2025 and already lapsed more than 6 months. Therefore it is just and proper to dispose this petition. Hence, proceed and pass following;

ORDER

The execution petition filed by Dhr is hereby disposed off. **In view of the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in RSB.No.163/2025 dated 01.04.2025 and in view of the directions passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.3640-3642/2025(arising out of Slp (c)8490/8492/2020 (Periyammal (Dead) through Lrs and ORS V/s V. Rajamani and Anr etc.,).**

Prayer of counsel for Dhr rejected.
