ISSUES

1. Whether the petitioner proves that on 23.09.2024 at 7.30 p.m., when he was proceeding in his Passion Pro motorbike bearing Reg.No.KA-11-Y-5643 from Yalavarakoppalu village to Mysuru, near Ganapathi temple of Kiranguru village, at that time, the rider of Bajaj C.T. motorbike bearing No.KA-05-EZ-0677 riding in a rash and negligent manner so as to endangers to human life, and dashed to the motorbike of the petitioner and he fell down, as a result, he has sustained grievous injuries?

2. Whether the respondent No.3 proves that the accident occurred due to the sole negligence on the part of petitioner?

3. Whether the respondent No.3 proves that the petition is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?

4. Whether the petitioner is entitled for compensation? If so, what is the compensation and from whom?
5. What order or award?
