**ORDER**

Both counsel for petitioner and Respondent No.2 are present and have filed joint compromise petition and copy of Adhaar Card self attested by the petitioner.

Dispute between petitioner and respondent No.2 have amicably settled, Respondent No.2 agreed to settle to claim to full and final settlement for Rs.80,000/- and prays to pass an award accordingly.

Considering facts and circumstances of the case, court is of the opinion that the terms of compromise are reasonable, acceptable and lawful. Learned counsel for petitioner prays to release the entire amount

considering medical expenses and financial hardship faced by the petitioner. Therefore, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, court is of the considered opinion that it is a fit case for release of the entire compensation amount. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

**-:: ORDER ::-**

*The Joint Memo filed by the parties is hereby accepted.*

*The petitioner is entitled for release of entire compensation amount.*

*The Respondent No.2 shall pay the entire amount as mentioned in the joint memo within two months from today.*

*Petitioner shall submit Affidavits furnishing petitioner's nationalised bank account details with IFSC along with cancelled cheque having petitioner's name within 30 days from today. Petitioner shall also submit Copy of bank account passbook, Aadhaar card, and PAN card. The counsel for petitioner shall verify the authenticity of the details and submit the same to the office along with*

memo.

*Pending Clerk and CMO shall verify and endorse the correctness of the bank details in the order sheet to enable drawing of the award.*

*Office to include all above details of petitioner and draw award after receipt of memo from the counsel for petitioner.*

*The Respondent shall transfer the awarded amount to the bank account specified in the award and intimate this tribunal.*
