Case is ordered to put up today on IA filed by Smt. BRL advocate for petitioner. Perused IA and satisfied as to grounds to advance the case. Hence, IA is allowed and case is advanced to this date..

Smt. BRL advocate for petitioner filed IA No.6 u/o 5 rule 20 of CPC along with affidavit for permission to take steps against respondents by affixture as respondents deliberately evade process. Heard argument and perused IA and record. It appears that though this court has issued notice to respondents, notice were not returned. Now the petitioner intended to take sub service. Hence, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that it is a fit case to permit the petitioner to take sub service against respondents. Hence IA 6 is allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is permitted to take sub service against respondents by way of affixture.

Issue notice to respondents by sub-service by way of affixture and direct the concerned to affix notice on the conspicuous house of respondents.
