ORDERS ON IA NO.II

Case called out. Plaintiff called out absent. Heard the Learned counsel Sri.CRS for the plaintiff on IA No. II, perused plaint averments, IA, affidavit and documents.

The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants seeking permanent injunction with respect to suit property.

I.A.No.I is filed under the provisions of Section 80 of CPC, requesting to dispense with the issuance of notice U/Sec. 80 of CPC to the defendants as the matter is very urgent one by permitting to file this suit. IA No.I has been allowed by the this Court and permitted to file this suit against the defendants.

I.A.No.II is filed under the provisions of Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC, seeking ad-interim exparte temporary injunction.

This is a suit against the Govt. As per Sect.80(2) of CPC, a Suit to obtain an urgent or immediate relief against the Government or any public officer in respect any act purporting to be done by such public officer in his official capacity, may be instituted, with the leave of the Court, without serving any notice as required by Sub-Section(1); but the Court shall not grant relief in the suit, whether interim or otherwise, except after giving to the Government or public official, as the case may be, a reasonable opportunity of showing cause in respect of the relief prayed for in the suit.

On considering and assessing the plaint averments, IA, affidavit and documents placed on records, at this stage of the litigation this court is of the considered view that before passing any exparte order on IA No. II, it is just and necessary to serve the notice on IA No. I & II to the defendants and to hear the

matter. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue emergent notice on IA No.I & II and suit summons to defendants, if P/F paid R/by:30.04.2026.
