The decision in *Laksh Vir Singh Yadav Vs. Union of India & Ors*, 2026 SCC OnLine Delhi 4491, seems to be not relevant on the aspect of territorial jurisdiction.

Vide separate order dictated in the court today, the plaint is directed to be returned.

Since the court has concluded that it has no territorial jurisdiction in view of applicability of doctrine of merger, as well as, doctrine of maximum damage, there is no need or occasion to comment on the merits of the applications pending seeking confirmation of the injunction order or vacation of the stay order.

All interim orders stand vacated. Plaint and court fees be returned after due endorsement and copy be retained. The ordersheets and record of the case be consigned to Record Room.
