ORDER

Present: None.

1. By this order, I shall dispose off the application under Section 483 of BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant/accused Anil Kumar for grant of regular bail.
2. The learned counsel for the applicant argued that the applicant is falsely implicated in the present case; that he is totally innocent; that the chargesheet has been filed and hence the applicant is no more required for investigation purpose; that he is a permanent resident of Delhi and is the sole bread earner of his family; and also that he has clean antecedents.
3. On the other hand, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State strongly opposed the present application, and argued that the allegations against the applicant are grave; that the applicant, the co-accused Prakash Pariyar as well as their associate/CCL were identified by the complainant during the TIP proceedings; and that recovery of stolen cash has been effected from the applicant.
4. The contentions of both sides are considered.
5. A perusal of the TCR reveals that, *inter alia*, the TIP

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proceedings of the applicant conducted on 28.07.2025 were successful, as the complainant had correctly identified the applicant. A seizure memo in respect of the alleged recovery of the stolen amount from the applicant is also on record. The evidence of the complainant is yet to be recorded. In case the applicant is enlarged on bail, the possibility of him attempting to influence or intimidate the complainant or the other prosecution witnesses cannot be ruled out.

6. Having regard to the aforesaid and to the entire facts and circumstances, no ground is made out to grant bail to the applicant. **The present bail application of the applicant/accused Anil Kumar accordingly stands dismissed.**

7. Nothing expressed herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

8. Let the TCR be sent back to the concerned court, alongwith a copy of this order.
