EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR :

Since November 2011, I am working at RFSL, Mysuru.

On 15.07.2017, a requisition was sent by ACP Hunsuru along with 11 sealed articles pertaining to Hunsuru PS Cr. No. 320/2017 to our office, through HC 27 Subramanya. Said articles and requisition were given at reception. After receipt of the said articles, they were numbered as PS 972/2017 and then sent to biology section. After receipt, I opened the sealed articles, and I found them as follows;

1. Machete
2. Blood clot,
3. Mud
4. Cement flake and mud
5. Blood sample,
6. one nighty,
7. One sweater,

8. One petty coat,
9. One blouse,
10. One shirt and
11. One knicker,

I subjected those articles to chemical and serological examination.

On basis of the test conducted, I gave my opinion that blood stains detected on article no. 1, 3, 4, 6 to 11 are of human being and belong to B group. Blood stains on article no. 2 and 5 were disintegrated, hence its origin and grouping could not be determined. Accordingly I issued the report through our Asst. Director RFSL Mysuru to the concerned Investigating Officer.

After examination all the 11 articles were repacked and our office seal was affixed on them and the same were sent back to concerned Investigating Officer. Now I am seeing the articles examined by me and I identify them. The machete is already marked as MO-1, Blood clot stored in plastic container is already marked as MO-2, Mud is already marked as MO-3, Cement flake is already marked as MO-4, Shirt is already marked as MO-5, Knicker is already marked as MO-6, Nighty is already marked as MO-7, Sweater is already marked as MO-8, Petty coat is already marked as MO-9, Blouse is already marked as MO-10, Blood sample is already marked as MO-11.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY ADV. FOR ACCUSED :

After how many days of the incident you have examined the articles witness deposed that on 18.01.2024 we have received the articles from that we have started to examine articles. We will not write RH factor while mentioning the blood group. All the articles are separately packed for sending for examination.
