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ANITA SACHDEVA v. NCT OF DELHI & ORS.

Present: Ld. counsel for petitioner alongwith other LR's have joined through VC.

Legal representatives report is filed. Taken on record.

Two applications under Section 151 CPC have been filed, one is for seeking issuance of citation through publication in newspaper and other is for seeking release of Gold and funds lying in Indian Bank Savings A/C: 433987888, IFSC: IDIB000D006 & Bank Locker Number 236 linked to Indian Bank Savings A/C: 433987888.

An application has been filed to allow the petitioner to operate the Locker No. 236 linked to Indian Bank Savings Accounts No. 433987888. It is submitted that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is scheduled for 28.07.2025, and for her marriage, the petitioner requires the gold items lying in the Locker No. 386 linked to Indian Bank Account No. 433987888.

It is to be noted here that the Locker originally belonged to Late Anil Sachdeva, who died in the jurisdiction of this court. The deceased left behind a wife, two daughters and a son. The wife is the

petitioner before this court and the son and the daughters have given their no objection for issuance of letter of administration in favour of their mother.

Considering the exigency shown by the petitioner on account of the marriage of her daughter, the Bank is directed to grant access to the petitioner to operate the Locker No. 236 linked to Indian Bank Savings Accounts No. 433987888 on furnishing an undertaking that the petitioner shall file an inventory within 06 months from the date of grant of Letter of Administration, containing a true estimate of the property in possession and also all the debts owing by the deceased persons and shall in like manner within one year exhibit an account of estate showing the assets which have come into their hands and the manner in which they have been applied or disposed of and on filing of court fees proportionate to the value of the jewellery lying in the said locker.

Further, the letter of administration in respect of the other immovable and movable assets shall be issued after conclusion of the trial of the present petition.

Bank Manager for compliance on filing of undertaking and on payment of court fees based upon the valuation report of the authorized valuer. The concerned Bank Manager is directed to give access to the Locker for the purpose of valuation.

Let the publication fees be deposited with the Nazarat Branch and issue fresh notice to the concerned S.D.M to file the valuation report of the immovable properties bearing No. 19/251, Sarai Rohilla, Old Rohtak Road, Near Usha Mata Mandir, Delhi-110035 and M-43A, Shastri Nagar, Delhi-110052 on filing of P.F.

In view of the aforesaid, the two applications under Section 151 CPC stand **disposed off**.
