EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR :

I am working as a Associate Professor in Department of Forensic Medicine College, Mysuru since 2017. On 24.08.2019 I received a requisition from P.I. of Laxmipuram PS Mysuru to conduct the post mortem of a deceased lady by name Nagaratna aged 84 years. I commenced the post mortem at 12 noon and completed the post mortem examination at 1 pm.

2. The said dead body is that of a female aged about 84 years fair in complexion, moderately built and narrished. Length of the dead body was 150 cms. Post mortem staining present on the back of the dead body and fixed. Rigor martius present all over the body. Eyes closed. Pupils dilated and fixed. Mouth closed. Dentures present in both jaws, lips, gums, tongue and oralmucose intact. Fecal stains present around anus, buttocks and perineum.

3. I noticed the following external injuries.

- Contusion measuring 1x1 cms on the right cheek; situated 1 cm outer to left angle of mouth.
- Contusion measuring 2x1.8 cms on the outer aspect of left elbow.

4. On internal examination scalp and skull intact. Membrane intact, Brain and spinal cord, edemavoul and congested.

5. On examination of thorax, chest walls, ribs and sternum intact. Pleura and cavity intact. Laryns and trachia intact. Lungs right and left congested, edemavoul, cut section exodus frothy blood. Pericardium, heard and large vessels, Heard weighs 350 grms, epicardial fat increased, left ventricle - 1.2 cms, and right ventricle - 0.5 cms.

6. All coronary arteries thicken and calcified with left anterior descending - more than 90% occluded, left circumflex more than 70-80% occluded, Right coronary - 60-70% occluded, reddish discoloration present in left ventricular wall in anterior wall. Lateral wall and anterior wall over an area of 6x8 cms.

7. Abdomen- Wall intact, peritoneum intact, mouth, pharynx and oesophagus intact. Stomach and its contents contains 100 ml of light brown colored fluid with partly digested. Badam reads no peculiar smell, Small and Large intestine contains gas and its contents. Liver congested, Spleen congested. Genito urinary system, both kidneys congested bladder intact and empty. Organs of generation external and internal i.e., genitalia intact atrophic cavity empty.

8. All injuries of ante mortem in nature.

9. Continuous contusions are bluish in colour.

10. On investigation,

- Blood and viscera collected and sent to RFLS for chemical analysis through concerned police.
- Piece of brain, each lung, dissected heart, spleen, half of each kidney, uterus with adnexa collected and sent for histopathologist.

11. Clothes handed over to concerned police in a sealed cover with sample seal. To this effect I have issued PM report as per Ex.P.1. Ex.P.1(a) is my signature.

12. On 28.10.2019, after receipt of the RFSL and HP report, I am of the opinion that, death is due to cardiac arrest as a result of coronary artery insufficiency consequent to coronary artery decreased. However, there are contusions present over right cheek and left elbow. Further the cardiac arrest in the deceased mentioned in the PM Report, possibility of it occurring due to stress caused by assault cannot be ruled out. To this effect I have mentioned my opinion in Ex.P.1 and Ex.P.1(b) and (c) are my signatures. The aforesaid contusions are possible if a person is gagged the mouth by cloth by using force and also because this the stress and shock may be a reason for cardiac arrest.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY SRI.R.S.S. ADVOCATE FOR ACCUSED:

13. It is true to suggest that, my over all opinion with regard to the death of the victim is stated as Cardiac Arrest. It is true to suggest that, the said infirmities in the body of the deceased might have been caused because of her age as it is mentioned as 84 years. Witness further says that, the deceases of the heart may be due to the age factor. The external injuries might have been caused due to blood force. The said external injuries may be possible because of some other reasons also.

14. As per the questions being posed by the Investing officer, I answered that, the injuries might have been caused by using force. It is false to suggest that, at the instance of the police I have given a false report as per Ex.P.1. It is true to suggest that, because of age factor, the victim Nagaratna might have suffered heart attack and died. The word used by me as "Assault" in the report is mentioned by me as per the information furnished by the I.O. It is false to

suggest that, at the instance of the police I have issued the PM report to suit their purpose.
