**EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR :**

I have been Scientific Officer, Sr. Scientific Officer, Assistant Director in various capacity, Biology section, RFSL, Mysuru.

On 18.8.2020, I along with another Asst. Director Mr.Sujata K.M, Toxicology Section visited the crime seen at Nuggehalli koppalu pertaining Cr.No. 130/2020 of Bannuru Police Station. Upon visiting crime seen, we observed the crime seen and collected following articles from around the crime seen.

1) Blood stained towel, 2) Blood stained mixed with grass and mud, 3) Sample mud, 4) Blood stained mud, 5) Sample

mud, 6) Blood mixed mud, 7) Sample mud and 8) seven red colour glass bangle pieces. They were packed and sealed and handed over to investigating officer for further process. I.O took the photo Exp5 to 8. I appeared at photo Exp5 to 7. witness identified articles 1 to 8 at MO1 to 8.

On 13.9.2020, office received the 14 packed and sealed articles through PC 149 of Bannur police station in Cr.No.130/2020. These articles were registered with office no. RFSL/BS/657/2020. Those articles were sent to Biology Section, RFSL, Mysuru. I received the articles and subjected them for examination. All the articles were duly packed and sealed. The seals and descriptions were tallied with sample seal sent by I.O and invoice. When I opened the articles, I found that the following articles 1) Blood stained towel, 2) Blood stained mixed with grass and mud, 3) Sample mud, 4) Blood stained mud, 5) Sample mud, 6) Blood mixed mud, 7) Sample mud, 8) Contained nail scraping from right hand, 9) Contained nail scraping from left hand, 10) Vaginal swab, 11) Vaginal smear, 12) One saree, 13) One blouse and 14) One Langa.

I subjected above article no.1 to 14 for physical, chemical and serological examination. Based on the test result, I opined that "blood stain detected at article nos.1, 2, 4, 6 and 12 to 14 and these blood stain were of human 'O'

group of blood. The blood stains were not detected on article nos. 3, 5 and 7. The skin tissue was not detected in article no.8. Seminal stain was not detected in article no.10. Spermatozoa was not detected in articles no.11”.

Accordingly, I issued the report counter signed by the Deputy Director of RFSL, Mysuru and forwarded to concerned police. After examination, all the articles were repacked and sealed with office seal and sent back to concerned police.

I can identify the articles nos. 1 to 14. Article nos. 1 to 7 are MO1 to 7. Article no.12 to 14 are MO 13 to 15. Article nos. 8 to 11 identified by witness, they are packed and sealed. The packed and sealed article nos. 8 to 11 are marked at MO20 to 23 respectively. Report is marked at ExpP33, sample seal is marked at ExpP34 and signature is marked at ExpP33(a).

On 16.10.2020, office received the 6 packed and sealed articles through PC 149 of Bannur police station in Cr.No.130/2020. These articles were registered with office no. RFSL/BS/706/2020. Those articles were sent to Biology Section, RFSL, Mysuru. I received the articles and subjected them for examination. All the articles were duly packed and sealed. The seals and descriptions were tallied with sample seal sent by I.O and invoice. When I opened the articles, I found that the following articles 1) One reeper patti, 2) One

gunny rope, 3) One jeans pant, 4) One shirt, 5) One jeans half pant, 6) One shirt.

I subjected above article no.1 to 6 for chemical and serological examination. Based on the test result, I opined that "blood stain detected at article nos.1, 2 and 4 and these blood stain were of human 'O' group of blood. The blood stains were not detected on article nos. 3, 5 and 6.

Accordingly, I issued the report counter signed by the Deputy Director of RFSL, Mysuru and forwarded to concerned police. After examination, all the articles were repacked and sealed with office seal and sent back to concerned police.

I can identify the articles nos. 1 to 6 are MO9, 10, 16 to 19. Report is marked at Exp35, sample seal is marked at Exp36 and signature is marked at Exp35(a).
