ORDER BELOW EXH.1

Perused the record. It reveals that the accused has remained absent before the Court since the filing of the charge-sheet. From that date, summons and NBW have been issued from time to time, but the police machinery has failed to secure the presence of the accused for trial. On going through the record, it further appears that the case has been pending before this Court since 2022. It is also noticed that the CA report has not been filed along with the charge-sheet on record. In these circumstances, it is very difficult to proceed with the case. Therefore, in view of the special drive, I am constrained to stop the proceedings of the case under Section 258 of the Cr.P.C. (Section 281 of the B.N.S.S.). Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. The proceeding is hereby stopped under Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Section 281 of the B.N.S.S.).
2. The seized liquor in the present case be sent to the Collector, Central Excise Department, Solapur for disposal in accordance with law, after appeal period is over.
3. The bail bonds of the accused, if any, stand cancelled.
4. The case is disposed of accordingly.
