

ORDERS ON UNDER ORDER 7 RULE 14 C.P.C

This is the suit filed by the Plaintiff seeking recovery of Rs.5,98,382/- and Rs.1,15,311/- from Defendant in which now when matter was posted for Plaintiff evidence, the Plaintiff has filed present application under Order 7 Rule 14 of C.P.C. seeking permission to produce certain documents by condoning delay, contending that, while cross-examination of Plaintiff's witness they came to now that, the documents in question are necessary. Hence, they wants to produce the same.

2. To this application Defendant's counsel has filed objection stating that, the application is filed with delay without any valid reasons, documents in question are not at all relevant for the present case etc.,

On perusal of the facts and circumstance of the case it appears that, as application is filed when matter is posted for Plaintiff further evidence and application is for production of documents only it is proper and necessary to allow the application. Objections regarding relevancy and proof of those documents can be looked into at the time of final hearing of the matter. Hence following ;

ORDER

The application filed by the Plaintiff under Order 7 Rule 14 of C.P.C. is allowed.

Plaintiff is permitted to produce documents as claimed.
