EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR :

Since 2019 to 2023, I am worked as Senior Specialist at T Narasipura, Govt. General Hospital.

On 30.07.2021 at 11.00 am the P.I T Narasipura PS , Mysuru gave a requisition to conduct autopsy of deceased Lakshamma W/o Rangaiah. Accordingly, from 11.00 am to 12.00 pm, I conducted the autopsy of the deceased Lakshamma W/o Rangaiah at the Mortuary of T Narasipura Govt. Hospital.

During the autopsy I found that, body is that of female about 4 feet 6 inches in length poorly build and nourished. Black and white mixed hair scalp present. Abrasion dried and black colored seen on the left side of the eye boll and left zygomatic region. swelling seen over the left tempero Paritel

region. rigorous mortise seen on in 4 limbs. Eyes were closed no science of decomposition seen.

At the scalp region there is transverse undisplaced fracture of left temporal bone seen about 3.5 inches in length. Membrane intact accused counsel congested in the left temporal region EDH and SDH seen. at the brain and spinal cord region there is a intracerebral and hammorage seen.

At the thorax region all the organs are intact. AT the abdominal region all the organs are intact. At the genito urinary all the organs are intact and normal.

After examination of the body I have submitted the court that the death of the deceased is due to hammorage shock as a result of head injury.

I can identify PM report, Witness identify PM report same is marked as Ex.P.25. witness identify the signature, same is marked as Ex.P.25(a).

Also I have received requisition dtd 07.08.2021 from T Narasipura police station on 12.08.2021 for examination of weapon and furnishing of opinion. Along with requisition I have received article in sealed and packed condition. On opening I found a club. On examination of the said club I found that, the said club 28 inches long and 7 inches diameter. The said club in Y shape.

In requisition, opinion is asked as to whether the injuries mentioned in injuries on the deceased lakshamma on her left hear, chin, left eye and forehead are possible if assaulted with the weapon i.e., club and another opinion is sought as to whether the injuries on the back side of the head in the form of condition are possible if she fell on the road and weather in said injury is antimotom and same may cause death. Another opinion is sought as to due to which injury the deceased laskhmamma died. After examination of the weapon I have given my opinion that the The injuries found on the deceased lakshmamam are possible if assaulted with the said club and it is also opinion by me that, the injuries found on the back of the head of the lakshmma are possible if she fell on the road and the injury found on the back of the head is antimotom. The decease died due to the injuries of hammorage shocka as the result of head injury. Accordingly I have issued opinion

Witness identifies the requisition dtd 07.08.2021 same is marked as Ex.P.26. witness identifies his signature same is marked as Ex.P.26(a), witness identifies opinion dtd 12.08.2021 same is marked as Ex.P.27. witness identifies his signature in the final cause of the death same is marked as Ex.P 27(a). I can identified the weapon Witness identifies the is already marked as MO-1.

After examination I have packed and sealed the said article and sent back to IO. Clothes found on the body of the deceased are returned to IO.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY ADVOCATE FOR ACCUSED :

The death of the deceased lakshamma may be possible if she fell on the road and sustained injury on the back side of the head as mentioned in the second opinion at Ex.P.27. Witness deposed that, death may be possible. Deceased died due to shock as she fell on the road and sustained injury. Witness deposed that, due to neurogenic shock death may cause. It is false to suggest as per the request of IO I have given false report.
