EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR :

Since 2013 till now I am working as Assistant Professor in Department of Forensic Medicine, Mysore Medical College, Mysore.

On 03/07/2023 I received requisition from police inspector of Vidyaranyapuram Police station, Crime No:37/2023, U/S: 302 IPC to conduct postmortem of the deceased Unknown and conducted on the same day between 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm.

ON EXTERNAL EXAMINATION following observation of made.

Body kept in cold storage and deceased treated Dead body is that of a male aged about 60 years, measuring 162 cm in length, moderately built and poorly nourished, eyes partially opened, pupils dilated and fixed. Postmortem staining present over back of

the body and fixed. Rigor mortis passed off. IV line mark present over back of right hand. Dried blood present over right palm.

Following External injuries were found on the dead body.

- 1) Suture wound measuring 8cm present over right side of forehead, with sutures in situ and on removal of sutures underlying tissues shows extravasation.
- 2) Suture wound measuring 3 cm present over left side of forehead with sutures in situ and on removal of sutures underlying tissues shows extravasation.
- 3) suture wound measuring 4cm present over left temple and left side of forehead with sutures in situ and on removal of sutures, underlying tissues shows extravasation.
- 4) Multiple abrasions present over an area of 5x3cm over left side of forehead.
- 5) Multiple abrasions present over an area of 4x3cm over left temporal region.
- 6) Abrasions measuring 0.5 x 0.5cm present over right knee.

Following observations are made on dissection.

II- Cranium and Spinal Canal

Scalp: On reflection, shows extravasation all over scalp.

Skull: Intact

Membranes: Intact

Brain: Subdural and subarachnoid haemorrhage present over frontal lobes of both cerebral hemispheres.

- Subarachnoid haemorrhage present over parietal lobes of both cerebral hemispheres.

III- THORAX

Chest walls ribs & sternum: Intact

Pleura & cavity: Intact

Larynx & Trachea: Intact

Lungs right & left: - lower lobes of both lungs consolidated

- Cut Section exudes pus mixed with blood

Pericardium, heart & large vessels: Intact

IV- ABDOMEN

Wall: Intact

Peritoneum: Intact

Mouth, Pharynx & Oesophagus: Congested

Stomach & its contents: -Contains 100ml cream colour fluid

-Mucosa: Congested

-No unusual smell

Small & Large Intestines: Contains gas and its contents

Liver: Congested

Spleen: Congested

V- GENITO URINARY SYSTEM

Kidneys: Congested

Bladder: Empty

Organs of generation external & internal: Intact

Fractures/Dislocations/ More detailed description of injury or disease

- All the injuries sustained are antemortem in nature.
- Abrasions are covered with blackish scab, fallen off at places.
- Sternum collected and handed over to concerned police for DNA analysis.
- Blood and viscera sent to RFSL for chemical analysis.
- Blood soaked gauze collected and handed over to concerned police for blood grouping.
- Opinion reserved pending for want of chemical analysis report.

After receipt of the FSL report I formed opinion about final cause of Death which is as under;

Opinion: On perusal of autopsy findings, chemical analysis report and hospital case sheet, I am of the opinion that death is due to complications of head injury sustained.

On 23.08.2023 I issued final opinion about the death. The document now shown to me PM report and final opinion. Signatures on those documents are mine. Said PM report and Final opinion are marked Ex.P.52 and 53 and Signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P.52(a) and 53(a).

WEAPON EXAMINATION (1)

On 17.08.2023 I received 3 articles from I.O stating that, those are the weapon used during the alleged incident. The following on the weapon examined by me and my opinion.

- 1) One Cement brick
- 2) Cement brick in two piece
- 3) wooden log

Opinion: It cannot be opined with certainty as the injuries are sutured.

The articles are marked as M.O.6, 9 and 12, now shown to me are the articles examined by me.

The documents now shown to me are the opinions issued by me about said articles. Signatures on those documents are mine. Said documents are marked Ex.P.54 to 56 and Signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P.54(a) to 56(a).

When I received those articles it were in sealed condition and seals were intact. After examination I sent back those documents in sealed manner along with sample seal. Sample seal now shown to me, is the sample seal sent by me. Said Sample seal marked as Ex.P.57.

After postmortem examination I.O had sent Case sheet of the deceased and injuries mentioned in the case sheet could be caused by the articles examined by me and if injuries are caused by using those articles same are sufficient to cause of death.

ಎಂದರೆ ಅಂತಹ ಸಾಧ್ಯತೆಗಳು ಬಹಳಷ್ಟು ಕಡಿಮೆ ಮತ್ತು ಆ ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿ ಅಂತಹ ಯಾವುದೇ ಔಷಧಿಗಳನ್ನು ತೆಗೆದುಕೊಂಡಿರಲಿಲ್ಲ.
