

Case called before Lok adalath.

Parties and their respective counsels are present.

Advocates for the parties file Joint memo signed by them and their respective parties.

It is stated in the compromise petition that parties have settled the matter by the intervention of the court for Rs.50,000/-, JDR has already paid Rs.20,000/- in the same to the DHR finance and he has agreed to pay remaining amount of Rs.30,000/- on or before 31.03.2026, failing which it is agreed that DHR is at liberty to recover the remaining balance amount in accordance with law.

Parties agree with the terms of compromise petition. It is clear that there is no coercion or undue influence in arriving at this settlement and terms mentioned in the compromise petition. Hence following.

ORDER

Commercial Ex 527/2022 is closed as settled between the parties as per compromise petition.

Compromise petition will be part and parcel of this order.
