This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.S.Ravichandran, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent and this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS for seeking bail.

Prosecution case is that the FIR was registered as against the Petitioner/Accused for the alleged offences punishable U/Ss.25(1B)(a), 3 of Arms Act and 5 of Explosive Substance Act for the alleged occurrence on 01.08.2026 and the Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.08.2026.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that the Respondent Police have registered an FIR as against the Petitioner/Accused and he is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged in FIR. He further stated that the arms property is recovered from A1 but he is only friend of A1. He is innocent and no way connected with the offence. He is ready to obey any condition imposed on him. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 12 days.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 12 days only. The offence is grave in nature. The investigation has not yet been completed. Hence, she has serious objection to release the Petitioner/Accused on bail.

Heard both sides.

Considering the rival submissions of both sides and considering the strong objection of the learned Public Prosecutor and facts and circumstances of the case and considering that the offence is grave in nature and also considering that the investigation has not yet been completed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
