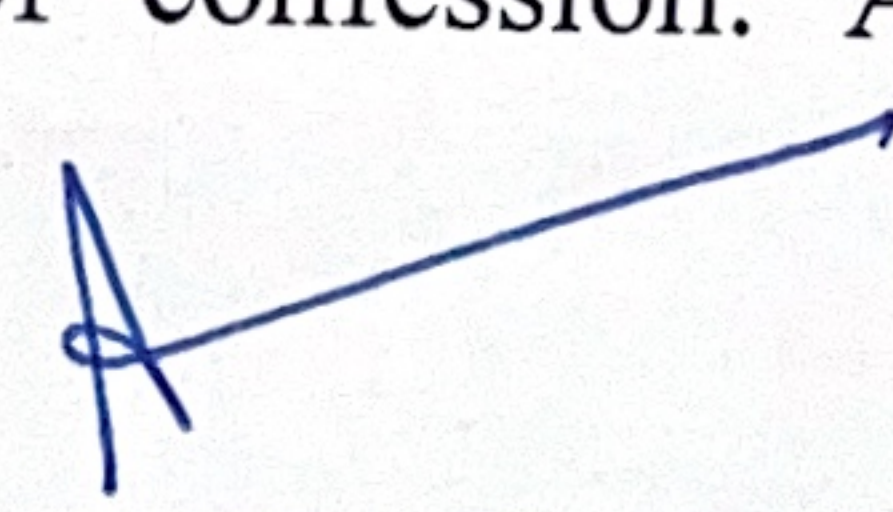

ORDER

1. The instant challan is presented before this court by Ld.APP in presence of I/O and accused person in open Court, report is called from office, perused the office report. From the perusal of the report, challan is complete. Let the same be entered in the concerned register and uploaded in CIS System.
2. At this stage accused through his counsel moved an application confessing the guilt under sections 223 BNS and 11 PC Act of in case FIR no. 51/2026 registered at Police Post J.T. The accused was made to understand that he is not bound to make confession and if he chooses to do so, he may be convicted and sentenced to imprisonment or fine or both. The matter was adjourned for a while. When the matter was again taken for hearing, the accused time and again proceeded for voluntarily confession. Upon this, statement of accused in support of application is recorded and placed on record. The accused person has confessed the guilt and I am satisfied that the confession is made voluntarily, and he has prayed for a lenient view. Prosecution has not proved previous conviction of accused nor there is anything on record which shall substantiate that he is a habitual offender, as such he is convicted of imprisonment till rising of Court and sentenced to fine to the tune of Rs. 2500/- for offence under section 223 BNS and a fine of Rs.50/- for the commission of the offence u/s 11 PC Act. Accused has deposited above said fine vide GR.No. 9992217 dated: 29/04/2026 and the same is remitted to Government treasury under rules. Seized property if any be released in favor of the lawful claimant after proper verification and against proper receipt.
3. Challan is accordingly disposed of, in light of confession. After due compilation be consigned to records.
