

Learned counsel for the DHr and DHr are present.

Learned counsel for DHr seeks time.

However order sheet reveals that even after sufficient opportunities the DHr has not ensured execution of warrant. Mere payment of PF without giving any assistance for execution of the warrants shows lack of due diligence on the part of DHr.

Hence, no grounds are made out to adjourn the matter any further.

Hence, the following:

ORDER

“In exercise of powers vested in this court under order 17 rule 2 and 3 of CPC R/w section 9 of CPC, the execution petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution in view of the absence of the Dhr despite the Dhr being called for hearing and for failure to take steps.”
