Bedi, Advocate has filed Power of Attorney on behalf of defendant No.4.

Summons issued against the defendant No.3 has been
received back duly effected, but despite calling the case several time since
morning till now at 04:20 PM, none has turned up on behalf of defendant
No.3. Hence, the defendant No.3 is hereby proceeded against *ex-parte*.

Adjournment is requested by the learned counsel for the
defendants No.1, 2 & 4. Heard. Request considered and allowed. In the
interest of justice, adjournment is granted. Now the case is adjourned to
23.10.2025 for filing written statement. POA by defendant No.1 be filed
on the date fixed.

It is observed that **in order to accommodate** the *action plan*
laid down by the Hon'ble High court and to prioritize *disposal of five-*
year-old cases and cases pertaining to *senior citizens*, this Court is
constrained to grant a long adjournment in the present matter, the same is
not opposed by either party.
