

Case called before National Lok Adalath.

Sri. S.R., advocate filed NOC vakalath for petitioner.

The petitioner and respondent No. 2 have filed a joint memo stating that, the respondent has agreed to settle the claim in full and final settlement for a sum of **Rs.8,28,749/- (Rupees Eight lakhs twenty eight thousand seven hundred and forty nine only)**. The compromise is lawful. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

:ORDER:

The petition is allowed in terms of joint memo.

The respondent No. 2 is hereby directed to pay **Rs.8,28,749/- (Rupees Eight lakhs twenty eight thousand seven hundred and forty nine only)** as agreed to the petitioner within 3 months, from the date of receipt of copy of award, failing which the said amount shall carry interest at the rate of 6% p.a from the date of award.

Considering the request made by the counsel for the petitioner that already the petitioner has spent huge amount towards medical expenses the entire amount is necessary to release in favour of petitioner on proper identification.

The respondent No. 2 is directed to deposit the amount directly to the account of the petitioner the details of which are as under:

The Respondent No. 2 shall deposit the amount at the earliest without causing unnecessary delay.
