

141 CC NI ACT / 981/2025 ANIL KUMAR Vs. SURESH KUMAR

There is pendency of more than 19,000 cases in the present court, therefore, it is not possible to give shorter date in the cases.

Present : Complainant in person with Ld. Counsel Sh. Sandeep Kumar.

The data available on CIS show that the present complaint has been efiled on 13.01.25.

Let notice on the present complaint be issued to the proposed accused in terms of the proviso to section 223 (1) BNSS upon filing of PF within two weeks from today returnable for **23.09.25**. If the proposed accused fails to appear on the NDOH (provided the notice is effectively served on the proposed accused and he is made aware of the court proceedings against him), the requirement of serving notice before taking cognizance u/s 138 NI Act shall stand fulfilled and the court will proceed with issuance of summons.

Ld. counsel for complainant is at liberty to serve the notice on the proposed accused through all permissible modes.

The Ahlmad shall ensure filing of duplicate copy of complaint along with PF.
