

Case is advanced and called before National Lok Adalath.

The next friend of petitioner, respondent No.2 and their respective counsels are present. The petitioner filed I.A. U/o 32 Rule 7 of CPC along with pleaders certificate submitted that the compromise is for the benefit of minor petitioner and the said application is allowed.

The matter is settled and counsel for the petitioners and respondent No.2 have filed a joint memo stating that, the respondent No.2 has agreed to settle the claim in full and final settlement for a sum of **Rs.5,60,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs Sixty thousand only)**. Hence, proceed to pass the following:

:ORDER:

The petition is allowed in terms of joint memo.

The respondent No.2 is hereby directed to pay **Rs.5,60,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs Sixty thousand only)** as agreed within 2 months, from the date of receipt of copy of award, failing which the said amount shall carry interest at the rate of 6% p.a from the date of award.

Considering the request made by the counsel for the petitioner that already the petitioner has spent huge amount towards medical expenses the entire amount is ordered to be released in favour of guardian of minor petitioner on proper identification.

The claim against R1 stands dismissed.
