

Witness called and duly sworn on: 26.02.2026

CROSS EXAMINATION BY: SRI. BGK LEARNED COUNSEL FOR RESPONDENT NO.3:

1. I have studied upto SSLC. I have little knowledge about the contents of the documents got exhibited by me. I was admitted to Hospital by persons from general public. One Sri. Girish S/o Subbanna who is the informant is my friend. The said Sri. Girish was riding the motorcycle on which I was proceeding as the pillion rider at the time of accident. Both of us were taken to JSS Hospital. The said Sri. Girish had sustained only minor injuries in the accident.

2. The history before the doctors at JSS Hospital was not narrated by me. From JSS Hospital I was taken to K.R. Hospital, Mysuru. When I was admitted to K.R. Hospital I was accompanied by the said Sri. Girish and my mother. Even before the doctors at K.R. Hospital I did not narrate the history. One Sri. Yashwanth is my friend and even he had accompanied me to K.R. Hospital. The information given to the doctors at K.R. Hospital may it be by the said Sri. Girish or Sri. Yashwanth would be proper and correct. Witness states that but I am not aware as to who narrated the history to the doctors at K.R. Hospital.

3. The offending Bolero goods vehicle came from rear side and dashed against the motorcycle on which I was proceeding as a pillion rider from the left side. Though I am aware that the motorcycle on which I was proceeding at the time of accident had sustained damages on the rear side but it was not major damage, but I am not

aware as to the nature of damages sustained by the offending Bolero goods vehicle.

4. The motorcycle on which I was proceeding at the time of accident belonged to the said Sri. Girish. The I.O., inquired with me about the accident about 3 to 4 days after the accident while I was undergoing treatment at K.R. Hospital. I was informed that the police had seized the motorcycle involved in the accident on very same day from the spot itself.

5. It is false to suggest that inspite of the fact that the Bolero goods vehicle bearing No.KA-11-A-7137 was not involved in the accident instead some unknown vehicle had caused the accident, the said Bolero goods vehicle was falsely implicated just to maintain this claim petition. Witness states that the driver of the Bolero goods vehicle made me to sit inside the Auto and assured me that he would accompany me to the Hospital but later he did not turn up.

6. Upon being suggested that Ex.P4 wound certificate issued by K.R. Hospital reveals that the said Sri. Yashwanth who gave the information to the doctors at K.R. Hospital had informed them that the accident occurred while I was proceeding as a pedestrian and was hit by a car, witness states that the said Sri. Yashwanth was not present at the spot at the time of accident as such he might have given the said information. It is false to suggest that with an intention to suppress the true facts, I have intentionally withheld the production of medical records pertaining to me issued by doctors at JSS Hospital.

Witness states that I have handed over the said documents to the I.O. It is false to suggest that I have falsely asserted that I was proceeding on a motorcycle as a pillion rider though I was proceeding as a pedestrian and was hit by an unknown car and to cover up the true facts, I have falsely asserted that I have handed over the medical records issued by JSS Hospital to the I.O.

7. The Honda activa scooter on which I was proceeding at the time of accident belonged to the said Sri. Girish. I have produced documents in that regard.

Deferred for further cross examination of PW.1 as court time is over.
