

ORDERS ON IA NO. III UNDER ORDER VI RULE 17 OF C.P.C.

The application under consideration is filed by the petitioner under Order VI Rule 17 of C.P.C. seeking amendment of petition thereby seeking that the petitioner may be permitted to rectify the error in mentioning the avocation of the petitioner at Para No.5 line No.1 and 5 and mention the same as Business and Agriculture as mentioned at Column No.5 of the petition, the purpose of avoiding any future ambiguity on the ground that due to typographical error the mistake has crept up in the petition.

It is clear from the perusal of the affidavit and the nature of the amendment sought in this application that the petitioner by way of this application seeks to rectify the errors which have crept up in the petition regarding the avocation of the petitioner at Para No.5 of column No.22. In fact at Column No.5 of the petition, the avocation of the petitioner is mentioned as agriculture and business but at Para No.5 of column No.22, at various places different avocations are mentioned, which, according to the petitioner are typographical errors. Since the amendment sought by way of this application are more in the form of rectification of errors in order to avoid any future ambiguity with regard to identity of the parties, this tribunal proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

“IA No. III under Order VI Rule 17 of C.P.C. filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed as prayed for.

Consequently, the petitioner is permitted to carryout the amendment as sought in the application.

The petitioner shall carryout the amendment within 14 days from the date of this order as provided for under Order VI Rule 18 of C.P.C. and also file the amended petition in compliance under Order VI Rule 15 of C.P.C. (Karnataka amendment)."
