Parties have already filed joint memo and agreed to settle the matter for a sum of ₹.7,60,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Sixty Thousand only).

2. Joint Memo is already filed reporting that the matter as settled

for a sum of ₹.7,60,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Sixty Thousand only).

3. The parties to the compromise are majors in age and appear to be competent to enter into compromise. The terms of compromise are legally enforceable and hence this court should not have any impediment to accept the same.

ORDER

“The joint memo filed by the parties to the petition is hereby accepted.

The petition stands disposed off as per the terms of joint memo.

The joint memo filed by the parties shall form part of this order.

Consequently the petition stands dismissed as against the against Respondent No.1.

The Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the amount at the earliest without causing unreasonable delay.

Considering the quantum of compensation and also considering the memo filed by the learned counsel for the petitioner setting out the details of medical expenses incurred; and also keeping in mind the nature of injuries suffered by the petitioner, it is just and necessary to release the entire amount to the petitioner, as the petitioner is capable of handling the money.

Draw decree accordingly."
